AUCTION: "FROM MY HOME TO YOURS"



MINUTES OF JUNE MEETING

Spokane Compass Club Luncheon Minutes June 5, 20018

Pres. Hildy checked with the interest group chairs who were present to see who would be continuing to lead their group next year. Most will be continuing with Kathy Catron taking

over leadership of the Culinary Corner group. The interest group chairs were recognized and thanked for their contribution to the club.

New Business:

Carol Hannah asked for votes for next year's philanthropy and a brief explanation of the 3 charities was given. They were Sally's House, Honor Flight, and Transitions 4 Women. She announced that we collected \$1,425 during the year from members and with the \$500 that is budgeted from the club it would be rounded up to \$2,000.

Old Business:

Drawings were held for 50/50 and the center pieces which were beautiful cakes made by Ann Fly for a special treat for the last meeting of the year.

The votes were tallied and the charity selected for next year's philanthropy is Honor Flight.

Last Saturday was the wine tasting at Petunia's. They said they have a supper club and they would be happy to do a dinner for us. They have a minimum number of 20 attendees and a maximum of 28. The date will be Saturday, August 4 for a Sicilian dinner of 4 courses for \$65 per person. Contact Maureen Boutz for reservations.

Hildy is changing the date of her BYOB to July 22.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:00 noon

The program consisted of a presentation of \$2,000 to Strolling Strings. The money will pay for 4 mics, receivers and a board to upgrade their sound system. New officers were installed and the current board was thanked for their service. A gift was presented to President Hildy Cox and the annual philanthropy prize drawings were held.
