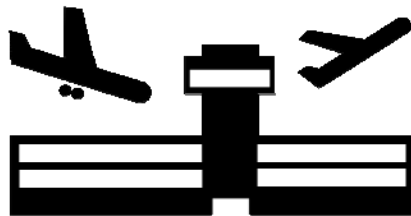
LUNCHEON

Bridge Group continues to meet the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month, starting at 1:00, with play rotating between member's homes. We are a friendly group that

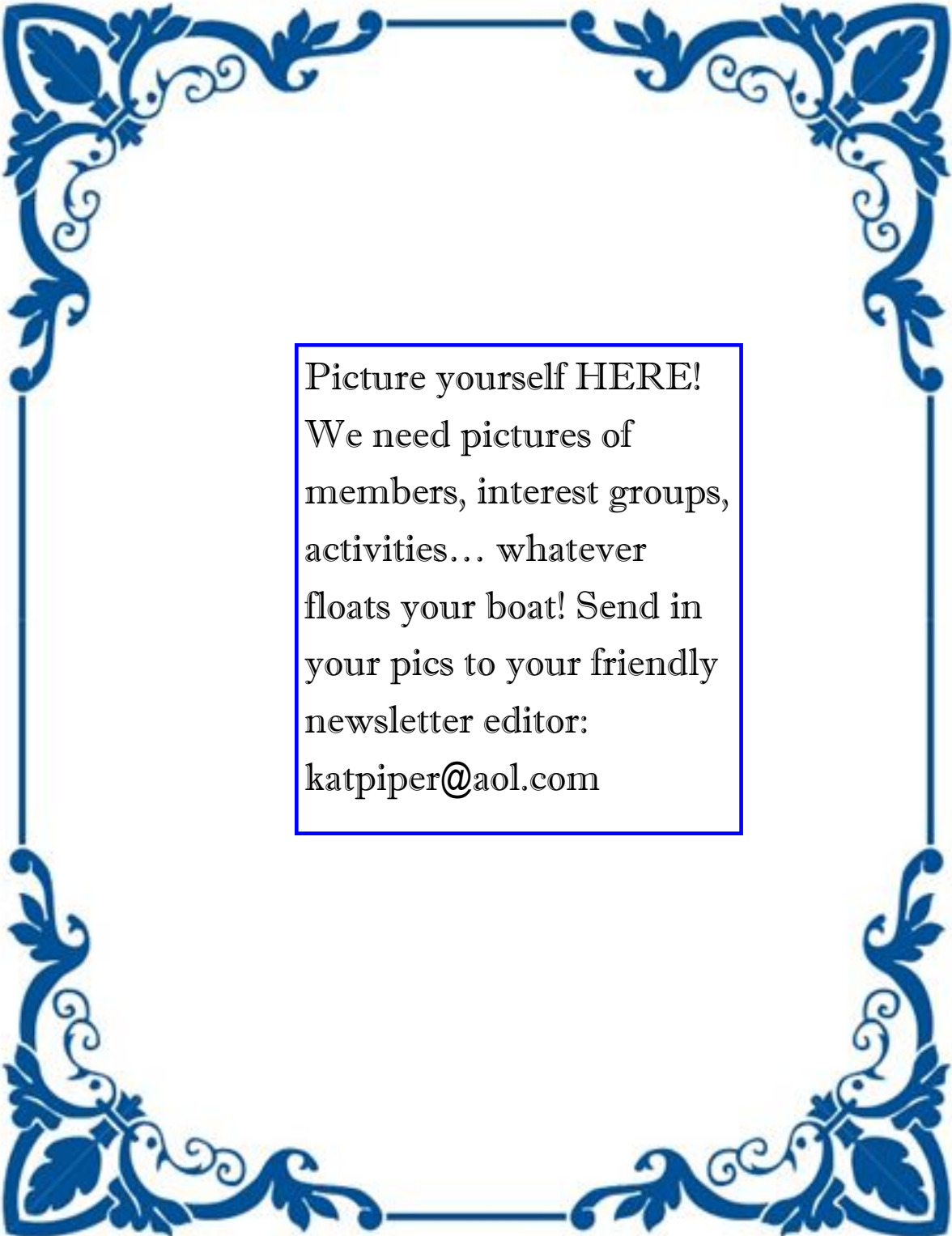


plays "party" bridge with an emphasis on learning. We always welcome new players as long as they aren't interested in "cut throat" games.

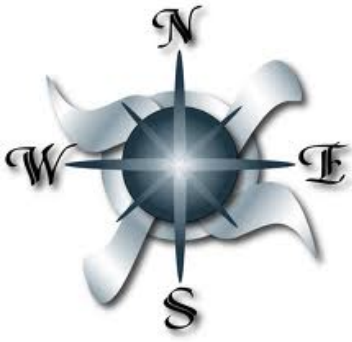
