***NOTE: Your Compass Club Board voted unanimously to provide our members with the June 4th luncheon at the Ramada Inn free of charge. The only stipulation is that**

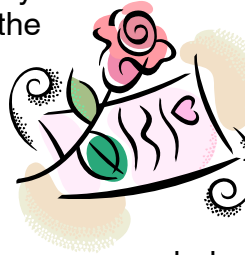
