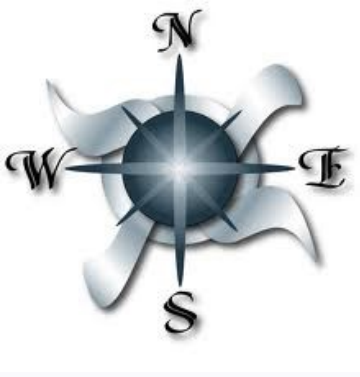


BRIDGE
