

Other Lunch News


We wanted to take a minute to explain the cost of our Compass Club luncheons for 2024-2025.

We contacted a large number of venues to find the best deals (and most delicious meals) for our members. Costs have increased dramatically over the past year. We avoided any venue that required a room deposit.

Compass Club luncheons this year will range in actual price from \$20.00 to \$40.00. For example, the luncheon at Manito Park cost \$20.00 per person, two luncheons (October and April) at Beacon Hill cost \$37.00 per person, and our Christmas luncheon will be approximately \$40 per person. The cost to each member will remain \$30.00. By the end of the year, we should average out very close to \$30.00 per person per luncheon.
